subsection shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars.

CHAPTER 344.

AN ACT to create subsection (15) of section 59.08 of the statutes, relating to the regulation and control of dance halls, road houses and other places of amusement.

A new subsection is added to section 59.08 of the statutes to read: (59.08) (15) Exercise all the powers conferred by law on cities to regulate by ordinance, dance halls, road houses, and other places of amusement outside the limits of incorporated cities and villages. The powers hereby conferred shall be in addition to all grants, and shall be limited only by express language.
