## CHAPTER 346.

AN ACT to create subsection (10) of section 84.03 of the statutes, relating to the improvement and maintenance of connecting streets in cities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new subsection is added to section 84.03 of the statutes to read: (84.03) (10) All streets in any city, marked as a part of the state trunk highway system, and forming connections through such city between portions of the state trunk highway system, or between such system and the highway systems of adjoining states, may be constructed or reconstructed by the state in the same manner as portions of the state trunk highway system.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 347.

AN ACT to repeal and recreate subsection (2) of section 45.07 of the statutes, relating to persons eligible to admission to the Grand Army Home for Veterans.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (2) of section 45.07 of the statutes is repealed.

- SECTION 2. A new subsection is added to section 45.07 of the statutes to be numbered and to read: (45.07) (2) The allowances appropriated by subsection (7) of section 20.03 are for the maintenance of employes who are actually maintained in the Grand Army Home for Veterans, and for the following members of the Home:
- (a) Soldiers, sailors and marines who have served at least seventy days in the Civil War, Spanish-American War, Philippine Insurrection, China Relief Expedition, The World War, or in any other war or military expedition of the United States, who were honorably discharged from such service, and whose services were
