CHAPTER 383.

AN ACT to create paragraphs (a), (b), (bm) and (l) of subsection (6) of section 20.60 of the statutes, relating to the state fair and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Four new paragraphs are added to subsection (6) of section 20.60 (as revised in chapter 67, laws of 1931) to read: (20.60) (6) (a) Operation. Annually, beginning March 1, 1931, two hundred forty thousand dollars for the operation of the state fair. All moneys collected or received by any person for or account of the operation of the state fair shall be paid immediately into the general fund.

- (b) Equipment. Annually, beginning July 1, 1931, fifteen thousand dollars for equipment, permanent property and improvements except the purchase of land.
- (bm) If in any year the receipts from the operation of the state fair and the state fair park paid into the general fund are less than the total of the expenditures under paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection, then the difference shall be taken from such other appropriations to the department of agriculture and markets, as said department deems advisable, but not exceeding fifty thousand dollars in any year.
- (1) All moneys collected or received by each and every person for or on account of the operation of the state fair shall be paid immediately into the general fund, except as provided in paragraphs (g) and (j) of this subsection. The state treasurer and secretary of state shall be in attendance at the state fair each year, then and there to receive such moneys and to audit and pay expenditures duly certified by the department of agriculture and markets as having been necessarily incurred in the operation of the state fair.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1931. Approved June 27, 1931.
