chases an inventory of all public printing of the second and third classes and all maps and charts on hand on the first day of July. Said \* \* \* director shall, from time to time, require the return to \* \* \* him of all such printing as has become, in \* \* \* his opinion, \* \* \* of no further use to the office reporting the same.

SECTION 13. Section 35.91 of the statutes is amended to read: 35.91 FUTURE DISTRIBUTION; SALES. The \* \* \* director of purchases shall, from time to time, file \* \* \* in his office a statement of the number of copies of each book, report or other document printed for the state by the state printer which he is required to reserve for future distributions according to law; also a statement of the cost, exclusive of the author's and other editorial work, of each such publication. The estimated cost of Wisconsin Statutes shall not include any cost of revision or of annotating.

\* \* \* He may sell, at said cost price, to any person any such publication out of any surplus on hand beyond the reservation so required.

SECTION 14. Subsection (5) of section 84.02 of the statutes is amended to read:

(84.02) (5) Maps. As often as it may deem necessary, the highway commission shall publish maps of the state showing thereon the trunk highway system and such other main highways and other features as may seem desirable. Such maps shall be furnished to the \* \* \* director of purchases upon the requisition of the highway commission and shall be sold by \* \* \* him, the price to be fixed by the commission, which price shall be not less than cost. The highway commission may permit the use of the base plates for other maps and publications in consideration of a fair fee for such use.

Section 15. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT to amend subsection (2) of section 29.31 of the statutes, relating to dip net fishing for rough fish in certain waters.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (2) of section 29.31 of the statutes is amended to read: (29.31) (2) Dip nets not exceeding eight feet in diameter with meshes of not less than three inches may be used for taking, catching or killing rough fish at any time in any of the waters of Kewaunee and Manitowoc counties and in the daytime only, in the Fond du Lac river within three miles of its mouth; in Silver creek in the town of Ripon, Fond du Lac county, from the old Arcade dam to the Green Lake county line; in the Big Wolfe river below the Shawano county line; in the Milwaukee river from its mouth to a point twenty miles inland and in that part of the Rock river lying in Jefferson and Dodge counties and Beaver Dam Lake in Dodge county; from the mouth of the Pine river to the dam at Poy Sippi and from the mouth of Willow creek up to the dam at Aurorahville, in Waushara county; the Crawfish river from its mouth up to bridge number four in the town of Beaver Dam, Dodge county, and in all the streams and rivers flowing into Lake Michigan and Green Bay in that part of such streams beginning at the mouth and extending ten miles inland.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT to amend section 29.191 of the statutes, relating to the open season for fishing in Juneau county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 29.191 of the statutes is amended to read: 29.191 There shall be no close season for hook and line fishing, except for large and small-mouthed bass, sturgeon and trout, in any of the following described waters: In the waters of the Mississippi river, Lower Lake St. Croix and up the St. Croix river to the Dells, the bays and bayous connected therewith and in the waters of La Fayette, Iowa and Green counties; in the waters of
