CHAPTER 90.

- AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 88.075 and to create subsections (4) and (5) of section 88.075 of the statutes, relating to farm drainage districts.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 88.075 of the statutes is amended to read: (88.075) (1) Whenever the owners * * * of land who represent more than a majority of the confirmed benefits in a farm "drainage" shall file with the county judge having jurisdiction of such drainage a petition requesting that no more work be done in and no more expense made against such drainage, the court shall order a hearing thereon, notice of which shall be posted in three public places on or in the immediate vicinity of the land included in the "drainage" at least ten days before the date of hearing. If on such hearing the court shall find that such petition is signed by the required number of owners and that notice of hearing was properly given it * * * shall enter an order directing that no more work be done in or expense created against such "drainage", but such order shall in no way affect existing contracts.

SECTION 2. Two new subsections are added to section 88.075 of the statutes to read: (88.075) (4) The secretary of any such "drainage" having a bonded indebtedness shall continue to make an annual report as provided in section 88.13 and make a charge therefor notwithstanding the entering of an order as provided in subsection (1) herein.

(5) The entering of the order as provided in subsection (1) shall be effective and continue in force until a like application upon like notice requesting that work be continued, be heard and determined.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
