

Wisconsin Session Laws, 1933

CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT to create subsection (5) of section 14.50 of the statutes, relating to lost checks or drafts issued by the state treasurer.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new subsection is added to section 14.50 of the statutes to read: (14.50) (5) If any check or draft drawn and issued by the state treasurer is lost or destroyed and the bank on which such check or draft is drawn has been notified to stop payment thereon, the state treasurer may, after the expiration of seven days from the date of notice to stop payment, issue a duplicate check or draft and thereafter the state treasurer shall be relieved from all liability thereon.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT relating to auto registration.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. For the year of 1933 the date after which any person who shall operate an automobile, passenger automobile, bus, or motorcycle unless the same shall have been registered may be arrested pursuant to the provisions of subsection (1) of section 85.01 of the statutes, is changed from February first to April first.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
