any time prior to and including the return day, which shall be not less than six nor more than fifteen days from the date of issue, substantially in accord with form No. 2 of subsection 2 of this section 15, and in the meantime suspend the issuance in such actions of the summons shown in form No. 1 of said subsection 2, and provided, further that a garnishee summons, except in aid of execution, may be issued either at the time of the issuing of the summons or warrant of attachment or at any time thereafter before final judgment has been entered. The summons of said court may be signed, sealed, and delivered by the clerk to attorneys authorized to practice law in Wisconsin, and may be issued by them in the manner provided by and subject to the restrictions of chapter 20 of the laws of Wisconsin of 1903, as amended, except as to time of filing and except that any summons of said court may be served in any county of the state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 258.

AN ACT directing the state highway commission to add to the state trunk highway system a highway extending from Eagle River to the state line.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The state highway commission is authorized and directed to add to the state trunk highway system a highway extending from Eagle River in Vilas county to the Wisconsin-Michigan boundary line, following substantially the course of what is known and designated as county trunk highway P under the following conditions: In the year 1933, the state highway commission shall mark said highway as a state trunk highway, and during the years 1933 and 1934 the maintenance of said highway shall be borne by Vilas county. Thereafter said highway shall be maintained as are other state trunk highways.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
