CHAPTER 282.

AN ACT to create paragraph (c) of subsection (4) of section 71.13 of the statutes, relating to attendance of district attorneys before county boards of review upon request of assessors of incomes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. A new paragraph is added to subsection (4) of section 71.13 of the statutes to read: (71.13) (4) (c) The district attorney of any county or a member of his staff shall upon request of the assessor of incomes attend meetings of county boards of review and assist the assessor of incomes in appeals pending before such board.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 283.

AN ACT to amend paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 62.07 of the statutes, relating to annexation and detachment of territory.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 62.07 of the statutes is amended to read: (62.07) (1) (a) A petition therefor shall be presented to the council (1) signed by a majority of the electors in such adjacent territory and by the owners of one-third of the taxable property thereof according to the last tax roll or (2) if no electors reside therein by the owners of one-half of said taxable property, or (3) by a majority of the electors and the owners of one-half of the real estate in assessed value; provided, that no petition for annexation shall be valid unless at least thirty days and not more than forty-five days before any such petition is caused to be circulated, a notice shall be posted in at least eight public places in the municipality in which the adjacent territory is located, and a copy of such notice published in a news-
