CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT to amend section 14.32 of the statutes, relating to expenses of state employes not allowed for audit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 14.32 of the statutes is amended to read:
14.32 The secretary of state shall not audit items of expenditure for tips, portorage, parlor car seats other than sleeping car berths, or for expenses not necessarily incurred in the performance of duties required by the public service; nor shall he audit items of expenditure * * * *incurred while traveling outside the state* by any officer or employe of the state or of any department or institution thereof * * * *unless in the discharge of his duties required by the public service and after authorization* by the director of the budget, * * * *unless specific statutory authority exists therefor*; nor shall he audit items of expenditure for expenses of * * * *any officer or employe of the state or of any department or institution thereof * * * while attending any convention, association, society or meeting held outside the state unless otherwise provided by law.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 346.

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 2 of chapter 59, laws of 1933; to allot the state aid for elementary public schools for the school year 1931-32; and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It is hereby enacted that the state aid for the school year 1931-32, available under subsection (3) of section 20.25 of the statutes, shall be distributed on the basis of the erroneous certification made to the secretary of state by the state super-
