## JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the state-owned radio stations WHA and WLBL.

WHEREAS, The Wisconsin legislature is mindful of the activities of the state-owned radio stations, WHA and WLBL, in taking to the people noncommercial broadcasts of a high class; and

WHEREAS, It recognizes the service rendered to the citizenry in making these radio facilities available to all legislators for uncensored discussion on matters of public concern; therefore, be it

*Resolved by the Assembly, the Senate concurring,* That the legislature hereby expresses its appreciation and approval of the operation and use of the state-owned radio stations in the interests of the people, through the dissemination of information from the educational, governmental, agricultural and other service agencies of this state. Be it further

*Resolved,* That properly attested copies of this resolution be transmitted to the managers of radio stations WHA and WLBL.
