## CHAPTER 131.

AN ACT to amend 72.04 (1) of the statutes, relating to exemptions from tax of transfers of property to the American National Red Cross.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

72.04 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

72.04 (1) All property transferred to municipal corporations within the state for strictly county, town or municipal purposes, or to corporations of this state organized under its laws, solely for religious, humane, charitable or educational purposes, which shall use the property so transferred exlusively for the purposes of their organization, within the state, and all property transferred to banks or trust companies of this state, as trustees, in trust exclusively for public, religious, humane, charitable, educational or municipal purposes in this state, and all property transferred to the American National Red Cross or any chapter thereof, shall be exempt.

## **CHAPTER 132.**

- AN ACT to amend and revise chapter 20 and to make divers other changes in the statutes relating to state finances and appropriations, constituting the executive budget bill of the 1943 legislature, and making appropriations.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 14.09 of the statutes is amended to read:

14.09 The governor may appoint \* \* \* and fix the compensation of such employes as he may deem necessary for the execution of the functions of the executive office. He may at pleasure remove any of said appointees.
