330.20 (2) An action by the state or any of its departments or agencies or by any county, town, village, city, * * * school district or other municipal unit to recover any sum of money by reason of the breach of an official bond or the breach of a bond of any nature whatsoever, whether required by law or not, given by a public officer or any agent or employe of a governmental unit; such period to commence running when such * * * governmental unit receives knowledge of the fact that a default has occurred in some of the conditions of such bond and that it was damaged because thereof.

CHAPTER 352.

AN ACT to amend 85.01 (4) (g) of the statutes, relating to the licensing and registration of municipality-owned and operated vehicles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.01 (4) (g) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.01 (4) (g) Automobiles, motor trucks, motor delivery wagons, trailers or semitrailers owned and operated exclusively in the public service by the state of Wisconsin, or by any county or municipality thereof, and motor busses owned and operated by a private school or college and used exclusively for transportation of students to and from such school or college and not used for hire shall be registered by the motor vehicle department upon receipt of a properly filled out application blank accompanied by the payment of a registration fee of \$1 for each of said vehicles or trailers. The foregoing provision shall also apply to automobiles, motor trucks, motor delivery wagons, trailers or semitrailers loaned to the state or any county or municipality thereof for the duration of the war emergency and operated exclusively by the state or such county or municipality for civilian defense purposes. The motor vehicle department shall furnish one number plate * * * for each automobile, motor

truck, motor bus, motor delivery wagon, * * * motor cycle, trailer or semitrailer, of a special series and color, and said number plates shall be renewed each year so long as it is used exclusively in the public service or for such school or college transportation. Registration fees received under this paragraph shall be credited as from the town, village or city from which said fees are received. Automobiles owned by the state and used by conservation wardens may be registered in the same manner as privately owned automobiles.

CHAPTER 353.

AN ACT to authorize Monroe county to convey to Thomas D. Evans and Anna Evans of the town of Sparta in Monroe county certain lands therein described which were acquired from them by Monroe county for highway purposes in connection with the construction of the Sparta-La Crosse road in Monroe county known as Federal Aid Project 325-G (3), but which said lands are not needed or being used for such purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Monroe county is authorized to convey to Thomas D. Evans and Anna Evans of the town of Sparta in Monroe county, their heirs, executors or assigns, all right, title and interest acquired by Monroe county from Thomas D. Evans and Anna Evans, for itself and for and on behalf of the state of Wisconsin, in and to certain lands for highway purposes in connection with the construction of the Sparta-La Crosse road in Monroe county, known as Federal Aid Project 325-G (3) and which said lands are situated in Monroe county, Wisconsin and described as follows, to wit:

A parcel of land in the southwest one-quarter of the northeast one-quarter of section 22, township 17, north, range 4 west, bounded as follows: commencing at the southwest corner of said southwest one-quarter of the northeast one-quarter; thence north
