CHAPTER 406.

AN ACT to authorize the transfer of certain state owned lands from the jurisdiction of the public welfare department to the conservation commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There shall be transferred from the jurisdiction of the department of public welfare to the conservation commission the following described lands, to-wit:

A part and parcel of section 6, township 18 north, range 17 east, Winnebago county, state of Wisconsin, more fully described as follows: All that mainland and the island south thereof which lies south of the following described line: Beginning at the intersection of the west line of section 6, township 18 north, range 17 east, and the shore line of Lake Winnebago; thence north along the said west section line to the northwest corner of the said section 6; thence east along the north line of said section, 66 feet; thence due south parallel to the west line of the said section, 814 feet; thence south $38^{\circ} 30'$ east 119 feet; thence north $81^{\circ} 15'$ east 1217 feet; thence south $66^{\circ} 30'$ east 314 feet; thence south $61^{\circ} 15'$ east 1350 feet more or less to the state hospital fence; thence south by west 391 feet more or less to the shore of the said Lake Winnebago.

Such transfer shall be made subject to the right of patients and employes of the Northern State sanatorium to have access to said lands for recreational purposes.
