## CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT to amend 43.50 (3) of the statutes, relating to the time when school boards in first, second, and third class cities shall report to the common council moneys required for activities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

43.50 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

43.50 (3) The board shall report to the common council at or before its first meeting in September of each year \* \* \* in cities of the second and third class, and at or before its second regular meeting in October of each year in cities of the first class, the amount of money required during the next fiscal year for the support of such activities and thereupon, subject to the provisions of subsection (5), the common council shall levy and collect a special tax in the manner that other taxes are levied and collected, equal to the amount of money so required; but said tax shall not in any one year exceed the maximum mill tax rate prescribed for the school extension fund in section 65.08, for all the activities conducted in said city pursuant to this section, and said tax shall not be used or appropriated, directly or indirectly, for any other purpose.

## CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT to create 85.01 (4) (dr) of the statutes, relating to registration fees for busses used to transport persons to or from army or navy camps, or factories engaged in war work. The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.01 (4) (dr) of the statutes is created to read:

85.01 (4) (dr) Busses Used in War Work. For the registration of each motor vehicle having a passenger carrying capacity of more than 7 persons and used exclusively for the transportation of passengers as follows: (a) to or from any military or naval camp; (b) to or from any factory engaged in war
