CHAPTER 576.

AN ACT to create 20.385 of the statutes, relating to the purchase of land by the board of regents of normal schools and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

20.385 of the statutes is created to read:

20.385 PURCHASE OF LAND IN MILWAUKEE. On August 1, 1943 all excess or unused funds remaining in the appropriations provided in 20.38, not exceeding \$22,000, are appropriated to the board of normal school regents as a nonlapsible appropriation for the purchase of land, buildings and equipment in the city of Milwaukee. Such purchase shall be subject to the approval of the governor.
