145.02 (3) (a) Employ competent supervisors who shall be licensed plumbers, and other assistants, prescribe their qualifications and assign their duties. Except in the adoption of rules and regulations, the state health officer may act for the board.

CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT to repeal 145.11 (1) and to amend 145.01 (1) (c) and (d), (3) and (4), 145.05 (1) and 145.11 (2) of the statutes, relating to plumbing definitions and supervisors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 145.01 (1) (c) and (d), (3) and (4) of the statutes are amended to read:

- 145.01 (1) (c) * * * The water service piping from a point within 3 to 5 feet outside of the foundation walls of any building to the mains in the street, alley or other terminal and the connecting of domestic hot water storage tanks, water softeners, and water heaters with the water supply system.
- (d) * * * The water pressure system other than municipal systems as provided in chapter 144.
- (3) A journeyman plumber is any person other than a master plumber, who * * * is engaged in the practical installation of plumbing.
- (4) A plumber's apprentice is any person other than a journeyman or master plumber who * * * is engaged in learning and assisting in the installation of plumbing and drainage.

145.05 (1) The council of a city of the first, second or third class, having a system of waterworks or sewerage, or the officer
