course for preparing teachers, to confer such certificates, diplomas and professional degrees in education in testimony thereof as are usually conferred by other institutions of like character and rank; provided, that no professional degree shall be conferred excepting that of bachelor of education and bachelor of science, and such degree only upon completion of a 4-year course above high school or its equivalent unless otherwise provided by law. But when any state normal school shall offer a course for the express purpose of training teachers for country schools, the completion of which shall entitle one to the certificate mentioned in section 37.13, the course of study shall be the full and fair equivalent of the course of study prescribed for the county rural normal schools by the state superintendent.

Section 2. 37.12 of the statutes is amended to read:

College Courses. The board of normal school regents may extend the course of instruction in any normal school so that any course, the admission of which is based upon graduation from an accredited high school or its equivalent may include the substantial equivalent of the instruction given in the first 2 years of a college course. Such course of instruction shall not be extended further than the substantial equivalent of the instruction given in the first 2 years of such college course without the consent of the legislature, except that the board may prescribe a 4-year college course at any normal school which is not within a radius of 275 usual traveled miles from any other state supported institution of higher learning now offering a 4-year college course. The board shall have the power to confer upon persons completing the 4-year course such degrees as are usual in universities.

CHAPTER 582.

AN ACT to amend 36.17 of the statutes, relating to rates of tuition at extension centers of the University of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

36.17 of the statutes is amended to read:

36.17 The board of regents may maintain a summer session

and is directed to carry on educational extension and correspondence teaching and shall carry on university extension class work in such communities as have 30 or more students and where the vocational or other educational board shall co-operate by payment of the regular extension fees. When similar courses of instruction are given at the university and at any extension center or other place of instruction in any city other than Madison, the rates of tuition charged to students at any such extension center or other place of instruction shall be no higher than the rates of tuition charged for such courses at Madison.

CHAPTER 583.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named to certain persons of Marathon in Marathon county to compensate them for damages sustained by reason of the condemnation of mink furs and quarantine of livestock by the state department of agriculture to prevent the spread of anthrax, a contagious disease.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$3,920 to certain persons of Marathon in Marathon county, hereinafter named, to compensate them for damages sustained by reason of the condemnation of mink furs and quarantine of livestock by the state department of agriculture to prevent the spread of anthrax, a contagious disease. The name of each of the persons referred to followed by the amount of money to be paid him out of such appropriation for the damages so susstained by him follows:
