or of its dissolution, change its name or dissolve by the adoption of a written resolution to that effect, by a vote of the majority of its members present at a meeting called for that purpose, and by filing the same as herein provided. A certificate thereto affixed, signed by the commander and adjutant, or like or similar officers, stating the facts, including the date of adoption of such resolution, the number of members present at such meeting, and the number of members who voted for the adoption of the resolution, shall be forwarded to and filed with the secretary of state, and thereupon, the name of such corporation shall be changed or the corporation shall cease to exist as the case may be, except that in case of dissolution, it shall continue to exist for the purpose of winding up its affairs. No fee shall be charged by the secretary of state for such filing.

SECTION 6. The revisor of statutes is directed to make such other changes in the statutes as may be necessary to show the change of name of the Disabled American Veterans of the World War to the Disabled American Veterans.

## CHAPTER 354.

AN ACT to create 70.11 (25d) of the statutes, relating to the exemption from taxation of the lands of the Northern Wisconsin Lutheran Bible Camp.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

70.11 (25d) of the statutes is created to read:

70.11 (25d) All real property not exceeding 40 acres situated in the town of Three Lakes, Oneida County, and the personal property situated therein, owned by the Northern Wisconsin Lutheran Bible Camp, a religious corporation organized under the laws of this state, so long as the property is used for religious purposes and not for the pecuniary profit of any individual.
