CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT to authorize the director of the budget to purchase necessary materials and supplies for the execution of functions under Chapter 9, laws of 1947 (Bill No. 13, S.), and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The director of the budget is authorized to purchase forthwith necessary materials and supplies to enable him to perform the functions as director of budget and accounts beginning July 1, 1947 under Chapter 9, laws of 1947 (bill No. 13, S.). There is appropriated from the general fund to the director of the budget \$5,000 on the effective date of this act to carry out the provisions of this act.

CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT to amend section 14 of chapter 69, laws of 1891, relating to fees of the judge of the municipal court of Polk county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 14 of chapter 69, laws of 1891, is amended to read:
(Chapter 69, Laws of 1891) Section 14. The same fees in all actions, civil and criminal, that are now allowed by law to justices of the peace, it shall be lawful for said municipal judge to charge and collect, and * * * *two dollars* in addition thereto for each and every action, proceeding or matter had or heard in his court. All fines imposed and collected by said judge for the punishment of any criminal offense under the laws of this state, shall be paid over to the treasurer of said county in like manner as is provided by law for justices of the peace.
