CHAPTER 66.

AN ACT to amend 40.04 (6) of the statutes, relating to the valuation of lands for school district taxation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.04 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

40.04 (6) To vote a tax for the operation of the school, but the total tax voted in any year shall not exceed 2-1/2 per cent of the last * * * full equalized valuation of the taxable property in the district, unless the district maintains a high school, in which case the tax limit shall be 3 per cent of such assessment.

CHAPTER 67.

AN ACT to revise the heading of 18.03; to renumber saidsection to be 18.03 (1) and to create 18.03 (2) of the statutes, relating to transfer of records or materials to the state historical society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The heading of 18.03 of the statutes is revised to read: Transfer of Records or Materials to State Historical Society.

Section 2. 18.03 of the statutes is renumbered to be 18.03 (1).

Section 3. 18.03 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

18.03 (2) Any other articles or materials which are of historic value and are not required for current use may, in the discretion of the department or agency where such articles or materials are located, be transferred into the custody of the state historical society as trustee for the state, and shall thereupon become part of the permanent collections of said society.
