## JOINT RESOLUTION

Clarifying and declaring the purposes of 20.41 (22) of the statutes, appropriating money for study and research into the causes, prevention and cure of bovine brucellosis.

WHEREAS, 20.41 (22) and 36.21 (2) of the statutes, enacted by chapter 170, laws of 1945 require the board of regents of the university under supervision of the dean of the college of agriculture to do research and experimentation in the control of bovine brucellosis and appropriate money to the regents for such and related purposes; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this legislature that it was intended by said act that the money therein appropriated should be used in research and experimentation to discover: (1) whether animals vaccinated with brucella vaccine strain 19 can cause undulant fever in man; (2) a cure for brucellosis; (3) a better diagnostic agency than we have now to determine infected animals; (4) a test or method to segregate carrier from noncarrier animals that now react to the agglutination test; (5) all other ways and means to control or eradicate brucellosis in the state of Wisconsin; now, therefore be it

*Resolved by the Senate, the Assembly concurring,* That it is the declared sense of this legislature that the appropriation in section 20.41 (22) of the statutes is for the purpose of such research and experimentation; and be it further

*Resolved,* That properly attested copies of this resolution be sent to the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin, the President of the University and the Dean of the College of Agriculture.
