CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT to create 95.495 of the statutes, relating to sales of herds of cattle.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

95.495 of the statutes is created to read:

95.495 HERD SALES; TEST. (1) No person shall offer for sale or sell one-third or more of the bovine animals of any herd unless all of the animals offered for sale have passed a negative test for Brucellosis and tuberculosis within 30 days prior to such sale. A copy of the record of such test shall accompany the animals sold.

(2) "Accompanied" means that such record shall be delivered to the person acquiring title or possession at the time any part of the purchase price is paid or at the time possession is transferred, whichever occurs first.
