

CHAPTER 516.

AN ACT to amend 43.19 (2) and (7) of the statutes, relating to the common school fund income distribution.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

43.19 (2) and (7) of the statutes are amended to read:

43.19 (2) Annually, within 30 days after December 10, the state superintendent shall ascertain the aggregate amount of all moneys in the common school fund income received prior to December 1 in the same year and shall apportion such amount to the school districts in proportion to the number of children resident therein between the ages of 4 and 20 years, as shown by the census reports made pursuant to this section to the state superintendent for the year preceding, ending June 30 or May 30, as the case may be. *He shall also ascertain the unexpended balances credited to counties from previous year's receipts and shall add such amounts to the current year's receipts credited to the various counties before making the apportionment provided for by this section.*

(7) Every county, district, or city superintendent of a city of the fourth class shall provide, as nearly as can be, for the expenditure of accumulated unexpended balances of previous years of the common school fund income held by the county treasurer of his county for school districts under his jurisdiction for the purchase of library books in some equitable manner but no order for books shall be forwarded to the contract bidder later than September 15, * * * 1950 as a charge against such unexpended balances.
