- AN ACT to renumber 20.021; and to create 15.855 and 20.021 (2) of the statutes, relating to acceptance of gifts by the governor's commission on human rights and making an appropriation.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.855 of the statutes is created to read: 15.855 GIFTS AND DONATIONS. All gifts, grants, bequests and devises to the governor's commission on human rights for its use for any of the purposes mentioned in

section 15.85, whether made to the members or otherwise, are valid and shall be used to carry out the purposes for which made and received.

SECTION 2. 20.021 of the statutes is renumbered 20.021 (1) and given the subsection heading "GENERAL APPROPRIATION."

SECTION 3. 20.021 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

20.021 (2) GIFTS AND DONATIONS. All moneys received from gifts, grants, bequests, and devises as authorized by section 15.855 shall be paid into the general fund and are appropriated therefrom to the governor's commission on human rights for its use as provided in sections 15.85 and 15.855.
