CHAPTER 213.

AN ACT to create 41.01 (2a) of the statutes, relating to instruction of preschool deaf children and their parents.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

41.01 (2a) of the statutes is created to read:

41.01 (2a) Any school district which operates a class for the deaf and hard-of-hearing may provide instruction for preschool deaf children and their parents. The plan for conducting these classes shall comply with requirements set up by the state superintendent.
