## CHAPTER 241.

AN ACT to amend 66.30 and 157.50 (1) of the statutes, relating to authorizing 2 or more municipalities to create a joint municipal cemetery association.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 66.30 of the statutes is amended to read:

66.30 Any city, village, town, county or school district may, by action of the governing body thereof, enter into an agreement with any other such governmental unit or units for the joint or co-operative exercise of any power or duty required or authorized by statute, and as part of such agreement may provide a plan for prorating any expenditures involved.

SECTION 2. 157.50 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

157.50 (1) Municipalities may acquire by gift, purchase or condemnation land for cemeteries within or without their boundaries. \* \* \* In the case of towns \* \* acquisition and price must be authorized by the town meeting.
