CHAPTER 304.

AN ACT to amend 88.42 (1) of the statutes, relating to town drains.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

88.42 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

88.42 (1) Whenever any owner of agricultural lands in any town desires to install drainage upon agricultural land not exceeding * * * 80 acres in area owned by him, he may present a petition to the town supervisors of such town setting forth that: (a) he desires to install drainage upon agricultural lands owned by him, (b) because of the contour of the land there is no suitable outlet on lands owned by him, (c) such proposed drain will promote the general welfare and health of the community, (d) it is impractical for such owner to drain his land without crossing the lands of others, and (e) it is desired that a drain be laid out to a suitable natural outlet specifying the course of the drain and location of the proposed outlet and ownership of lands through which such proposed drain would be laid.
