CHAPTER 354.

AN ACT to amend 29.23 (3) of the statutes, relating to deer hunting.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.23 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.23 (3) In the areas in which there is a season for the hunting of deer *with firearms*, no person shall hunt during such season unless at least 50 per cent of the visible portion of his hunting cap and at least 50 per cent of his jacket, excluding the sleeves, shall be red *or orange*, or covered with a handkerchief or cloth of red *or orange* color. Any person violating this subsection shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of \$10.
