CHAPTER 371.

AN ACT to create 147.205 of the statutes, relating to injunctional remedy for enforcing provisions of chapter 147.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

147.205 of the statutes is created to read:

147.205 (1) If it appears upon complaint to the board of medical examiners by any person or it is known to the board that any person is violating any of the provisions of chapter 147, except sections 147.24 and 147.25, the said board or the district attorney of the proper county may investigate and may, in addition to any other remedies, bring action in the name and on behalf of the state of Wisconsin against any such person to enjoin such person from such violation or violations of this chapter.

(2) If it appears upon complaint to the board of examiners in chiropractic by any person or it is known to the board that any person is violating any of the provisions of sections 147.23, 147.24 and 147.25, the said board or the district attorney of the proper county may investigate and may, in addition to any other remedies, bring action in the name of and on behalf of the state of Wisconsin against any such person to enjoin such person from such violation or violations.
