CHAPTER 454.

AN ACT authorizing the state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, to sell and convey certain state property therein described, and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey to the city of Waukesha for cemetery purposes, at such price and under such terms and conditions as the department shall determine, a strip of land of the grounds of the Wisconsin school for boys containing 25 acres or less adjoining the south boundary of the Waukesha city cemetery; and the proceeds of such sale shall be deposited in the general fund and are appropriated therefrom to the department for the purchase and replacement of equipment at the Wisconsin school for boys.
