## CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT to provide for the donation of land to the city of Sturgeon Bay for purpose of maintaining a dock and boat harbor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. All right, title, and interest of the state of Wisconsin in and to the lands submerged beneath the waters of Sturgeon Bay adjacent to the original shore line of Sturgeon Bay and bounded as follows: commencing at the southeast corner of section one, town 27 north, range 25 east, Door County, Wisconsin; running thence north along the section line, 2,395 feet to a point where the section line intersects the original shore line as shown by the United States Government Land Survey, for a point of beginning; running thence northwesterly along the original shore line 135 feet more or less to the southerly line of the Chris Hansen property; running thence northeasterly at right angles to the shore line thru the waters of Sturgeon Bay a distance of 500 feet; running thence parallel to the original shore line southeasterly a distance of 220 feet; running thence southwesterly at right angles to the shore line a distance of 500 feet more or less to a point of intersection with the original shore line; running thence northwesterly along the original shore line a distance of 80 feet more or less to the point of beginning; are hereby granted to the city of Sturgeon Bay for the purpose of maintaining a solid pier and breakwater thereon for navigational purposes, for use as a municipal dock and small boat harbor for recreational and light commercial use only.

Section 2. This act shall take effect on passage and publication.
