## CHAPTER 528.

AN ACT to amend 97.02 (5) (c) of the statutes, relating to marketing skim milk as fatfree milk.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

97.02 (5) (c) of the statutes is amended to read: 97.02 (5) (c) Skim milk is milk from which a part or all of the cream has been removed, and contains not less than 81/2 per cent of milk solids. It may be offered for sale and sold as "Fat Free Milk" if the milk fat content does not exceed twenty-five one-hundredths of one per cent and the words "Skim Milk" printed on the container.
