CHAPTER 63.

AN ACT to amend 40.10 (2) (a), and to create 40.115 of the statutes, relating to the method of making school district disbursements in certain districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 40.10 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

40.10 (2) (a) He shall apply for, and receive, and if necessary sue for all money appropriated to or collected for the district, and disburse the same * * in the manner specified in section 40.115.

SECTION 2. 40.115 of the statutes is created to read: 40.115 DISBURSEMENTS, HOW MADE. In every school district specified in section 40.02, except a city school district, all disbursements from the treasury shall be made by the treasurer upon the written order of the clerk after proper vouchers have been filed with the clerk. Such disbursements shall be by order check and no order check shall be released to the payee, nor shall it be valid, unless signed by the clerk and treasurer and countersigned by the director. The provisions of this section shall apply to, and to the extent of any conflict supplant, any special and general provisions of the statutes relative to the disbursement of money from the treasury of any such school district.
