## CHAPTER 659.

AN ACT to amend 20.17 (2) and 20.17 (3) of the statutes, relating to appropriations for operating state welfare institutions, and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 20.17 (2) of the statutes, as amended by chapter 319, laws of 1951 (Bill No. 174, A.) and as revised by chapter 395, laws of 1951 (Bill No. 709, A.), is amended to read:

20.17 (2) On July 1, 1951, \* \* \* \$8,410,435 and annually, beginning July 1, 1952, \* \* \* \$8,498,855 for the operation of the state institutions under its management and direction \* \* \*. Of this appropriation there is allotted for the following purposes:

SECTION 2. 20.17 (3) of the statutes, as amended by chapter 319, laws of 1951 (Bill No. 174, A.), is amended to read:

20.17 (3) On July 1, 1951, \* \* \* \$636,900, and annually, beginning July 1, 1952, \* \* \* \$558,400 for materials and expense for property repairs and \* \* \* miscellaneous capital permanent property and improvements of state institutions under its management and direction. Personal services shall be paid from section 20.17(2).
