CHAPTER 666.

AN ACT to create 20.41 (25m) of the statutes, relating to research in rheumatism and arthritis and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

20.41 (25m) of the statutes is created to read:

20.41 (25m) RHEUMATISM AND ARTHRITIS RESEARCH. On July 1, 1951, \$15,000, and annually, beginning July 1, 1952, a sum sufficient, but not exceeding \$30,000, for the study of, and research into the causes, prevention and cure of rheumatism and arthritis and for the purchase of necessary apparatus, equipment, and supplies for use in carrying on such study and research. Of this appropriation allotments shall be made for personal services, and for research assistants, and expenses to most effectively carry out these purposes as the board of regents shall determine. This research program shall be activated as soon as practicable upon availability of the appropriation.
