CHAPTER 728.

AN ACT to amend 4.01 and 4.02 of the statutes, relating to the apportionment of assemblymen and senators.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 4.01 of the statutes is amended to read:

4.01 ASSEMBLY DISTRICTS. Until there shall be a new apportionment, the members of the assembly shall be apportioned among the several districts of the state as hereinafter mentioned, and each district shall be entitled to elect one member of the assembly.

The counties of Burnett and * * * *Polk* shall constitute an assembly district. The counties of Florence, Forest and * * * *Langlade* shall constitute an assem-

bly district.

The counties of Green Lake and Waushara shall constitute an assembly district.

The counties of Iron, Oneida and Vilas shall constitute an assembly district.

The counties of Rusk * * *, Sawyer and Washburn shall constitute an assembly district.

The counties of Ashland and Bayfield shall constitute an assembly district.

The counties of Price and Taylor shall constitute an assembly district.

The counties of Crawford and Richland shall constitute an assembly district.

The counties of Iowa and La Fayette shall constitute an assembly district.

The counties of Door and Kewaunee shall constitute an assembly district.

The counties of Jackson and Trempealeau shall constitute an assembly district.

BROWN COUNTY .-- The third, sixth, twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth, fifteenth, sixteenth, seventeenth, eighteenth, nineteenth, twentieth and twenty-second wards of the city of Green Bay shall constitute the first assembly district.

The first, second, fourth, fifth, seventh, eighth, ninth, tenth, eleventh and twenty-first wards of the city of Green Bay and the towns of Allouez and Preble shall constitute the second assembly district.

All the towns, cities and villages in the county, except the city of Green Bay and the towns of Allouez and Preble, shall constitute the * third district.

DANE COUNTY .- The sixth, seventh, fifteenth, sixteenth, seventeenth and eighteenth wards of the city of Madison shall constitute the first district.

The first, second, third, fourth, fifth, eighth and ninth wards of the city of Madison shall constitute the second district.

The tenth, eleventh, twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth, nineteenth and twentieth wards of the city of Madison shall constitute the third district.

The towns of Albion, Blooming Grove, Bristol, Burke, Christiana, Cottage Grove, Deerfield, Dunkirk, Dunn, Medina, Pleasant Springs, Rutland, Sun Prairie, Windsor and York; the villages of Cambridge, Cottage Grove, Deerfield, DeForest, Maple Bluff, McFarland, Marshall, Monona, Rockdale and Sun Prairie; and the city of Stoughton shall constitute the * * * fourth district.

SECTION 3. There shall be submitted to the vote of the people at the general election in November 1952 an advisory referendum on the question:

"Shall the Constitution be amended to provide for the establishment of

either senate or assembly districts on an area as well as population basis?"

If the above question is rejected by a majority of the electors voting on such referendum, SECTIONS 1 and 2 of this act shall take effect January 1, 1954, otherwise said SEC-TIONS 1 and 2 of this act shall not be effective.

SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 261, laws of 1951, it is the intent of the legislature, in enacting this act, that each part of the act be deemed to be essentially and inseparably connected with and dependent upon every other part. The legislature does not intend that any part of this act shall be the law if any other part is held unconstitutional.
