## CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 150; and to create 147.206 of the statutes, relating to midwifery.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 147.206 of the statutes is created to read:

147.206 MIDWIFERY. Any person who, on the effective date of this section, is practicing midwifery in this state under a certificate of registration issued him by the board may continue so to practice under such certificate but subject to the provisions of

ch. 150 of the 1951 statutes as in effect prior to the effective date of this section and subject to the other provisions of this chapter.

Section 2. Chapter 150 of the statutes is repealed.
