CHAPTER 268

AN ACT to create 49.09 (3) of the statutes, relating to the removal of dependents who have legal settlement for relief purposes outside of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

49.09 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

49.09 (3) Out-of-state residents. When a dependent person who does not have legal settlement in a county or municipality within this state applies for relief other than temporary medical care, if such person is found in need, the relief agency shall furnish temporary assistance and immediately investigate as to the legal settlement of such person. If it is found that such person has a legal settlement in another state and the municipality of legal settlement in such other state admits its responsibility for such person's relief and authorizes the return of such person to such municipality, then the relief agency in this state shall offer to the person requesting relief, transportation for such person, and for his dependents if necessary, to such municipality of legal settlement. After making such offer, such relief agency shall not be required to furnish further relief to such person or his dependents.
