## **CHAPTER 284**

AN ACT relating to the time of payment of a part of the compensation of the president of the senate and the chief clerks and sergeants at arms of the senate and assembly.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

That part of the compensation provided by s. 20.01 (2m) (a) of the statutes to be paid the president of the senate at the end of the regular session and that part of the compensation provided by s. 20.01 (3) (a) and (4) (a) of the statutes to be paid to the chief clerks and sergeants at arms of the senate and assembly at the end of the regular session, plus the balance of the cost of living bonus provided in chapter 283, laws of 1953 (Bill No. 790, A.), shall, in 1953, be paid when the legislature recesses.
