CHAPTER 313

AN ACT to amend 60.18 (12) of the statutes, relating to powers of town meeting.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

60.18 (12) of the statutes is amended to read:

60.18 (12) To direct, by resolution, the town board in all towns to exercise powers relating to the adoption and enforcement of speed ordinances conferred on village boards, and the town board in towns having a population of not less than 500, and having therein, one or more unincorporated villages, and the town board in towns contiguous to the limits of any city, to exercise all powers relating to villages and conferred on village boards by ch. 61 of the statutes, except such power, the exercise of which would conflict with the statutes relating to towns and town boards. Any such resolution heretofore adopted pursuant to existing law or hereafter adopted pursuant to this law, shall remain in force until rescinded.
