## **CHAPTER 344**

AN ACT to amend 70.47 (1) and 70.50 of the statutes, relating to time of the delivery of the assessment roll and the meeting of the board of review in towns.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 70.47 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

70.47 (1) The board of review shall meet annually on the second Monday of July, except in towns where the town board so determines it may meet on the last Monday of June. In towns and villages the board shall meet at the town or village hall. If there is

no such hall, it shall meet at the clerk's office, or in towns at the place where the last annual town meeting was held. In cities the board shall meet at the council chamber and in cities of the first class in some place designated by the tax commissioner of such cities. A majority shall constitute a quorum.

Section 2. 70.50 of the statutes is amended to read:

70.50 Except in cities of the first class the assessor shall, on or before the first Monday in July or in towns, where the board of review meets on the last Monday of June, on or before the second last Monday in June, deliver the assessment roll so completed and all the sworn statements and valuations of personal property to the clerk of the town, city or village, who shall file and preserve the same in his office.
