CHAPTER 359

AN ACT authorizing the state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, to convey to the Hayward Area Memorial Hospital Association the former Hayward Indian School and Hospital if transferred to the state by the federal government.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

In the event that the Hayward Indian School and Hospital is transferred by the federal government to the state of Wisconsin and accepted for the state by the state department of public welfare pursuant to s. 46.046, the department, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to convey such school and hospital to the Hayward Area Memorial Hospital Association (a nonstock, nonprofit Wisconsin corporation) for public use as a hospital without discrimination in admission of patients with regard to race, creed or

color, and without discrimination as to practice therein by any physician or surgeon licensed in this state.
