CHAPTER 393

AN ACT to amend 188.14 of the statutes, relating to corporate powers of the Military Order of the World Wars.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

188.14 of the statutes is amended to read:
188.14 CORPORATE POWERS OF THE MILITARY ORDER OF THE WORLD WARS. Any chapter of the Military Order of the World * * * Wars in this state shall have full corporate power to transact business in this state upon filing with the secretary of state a full and complete list of its duly elected officers, and shall by so doing become a body corporate. No filing fees shall be charged by the secretary of state for so doing.
