CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT to amend 319.50 (4) of the statutes, relating to the commandant of the veterans' home serving as trustee for members.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

319.50 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

319.50 (4) No person other than a bank or trust company or the commandant of the Grand Army Home for Veterans at King shall be guardian of more than 5 wards at one time, unless all the wards are members of one family. The commandant shall act only for members of the Grand Army Home for Veterans and shall serve without fee. Upon presentation of a petition by an attorney of the veterans' administration or other interested person, alleging that a guardian is acting in a fiduciary capacity for more than 5 wards as herein provided and requesting his discharge for that reason, the court, upon proof substantiating the petition, shall require a final accounting forthwith from such guardian and shall discharge him from guardianship in excess of 5 and forthwith appoint a successor.
