CHAPTER 95.

AN ACT authorizing the state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, to sell and convey certain state property therein described, and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized on behalf of the state to sell and convey, at such price and under such terms and conditions as the department shall determine, that parcel of land known as the Mendota Colony I Farm containing about 225 acres, more or less; and the proceeds of such sale shall be deposited in the general fund and are appropriated to the department for the purchase of agricultural lands and buildings near to the Oregon State Farm and other capital equipment or buildings.
