## CHAPTER 151

AN ACT authorizing the state department of public welfare to sell and convey a portion of the state-owned lands connected with the Wisconsin school for the visually handicapped at Janesville, Wisconsin, and crediting the proceeds therefrom to the appropriation made by s. 20.175 (1) of the statutes and authorizing said department to expend therefrom amounts for the paying of the expenses of such sale.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The director of the department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey that portion of the state-owned lands which are now a part of the premises of the Wisconsin school for the visually handicapped, which lie westerly of a north-south line parallel to and 365 feet west of the center line of section 2, township 2 north, range 12 east, Rock county, Wisconsin, under such terms, conditions and covenants as the director shall determine; and the proceeds of such sale or sales shall be deposited in the general fund and credited to the appropriation made by section 20.175 (1) of the statutes and the department of public welfare is authorized to pay the expenses of such sale or sales out of said revolving appropriation.
