## CHAPTER 173

- AN ACT to amend 20.06 (1) of the statutes, relating to refunds of non-resident general hunting license fees and resident deer hunting license fees.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
  - 20.06 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 20.06 (1) Moneys paid into any fund of the treasury as a deposit or advance payment; and if such moneys have been credited to an appro-

priation, such appropriation shall, at the time of making such refunds, be charged therewith. License fees may be refunded under this section when the license for which a fee was paid cannot be issued for any reason, or when a refund is requested prior to the beginning of the license year for which the fee was paid, unless other procedures are provided by law. Nonresident general hunting license fees and resident deer hunting license fees may be refunded upon approval of the conservation commission when an open season for hunting deer with firearms has been postponed or canceled and said commission has found that the applicant for such refund was unable to avail himself of the privileges of the license because of such postponement or cancellation.
