CHAPTER 18

AN ACT to amend 1.10 of the statutes, relating to state fish.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1.10 of the statutes is amended to read:

1.10 STATE TREE, FLOWER, BIRD, FISH. The Wisconsin state tree is the sugar maple (acer saccharum); the Wisconsin state flower is the wood violet (viola papilionacea); the Wisconsin state bird is the robin (turdus migratorius); the Wisconsin state fish is the muskellunge (Esox masquinongy masquinongy Mitchell).
