CHAPTER 192

AN ACT to amend 97.02 (5) (a) of the statutes, relating to butter fat content in milk.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

97.02 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

97.02 (5) (a) Milk is the whole, fresh, clean, lacteal secretion obtained by the complete milking of one or more healthy cows, excluding that Underscored, stricken, and vetoed text may not be searchable. If you do not sed text of the Act, SCROLL DOWN.

obtained within 15 days before and 5 days after calving, or such longer period as may be necessary to render the milk colostrum-free. * * * Milk shall contain not less than 3 per cent of milk fat, and not less than 8.25 per cent of milk solids not fat. Milk may be standardized by the addition or removal of cream or by the addition of skim milk. When so standardized milk shall contain not less than 3.25 per cent of milk fat, and not less than 8.25 per cent of milk solids not fat.
