## CHAPTER 255

AN ACT to repeal 28.02 (7); and to repeal and recreate 28.02 (4) of the statutes, relating to sale of state forest lands.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 28.02 (4) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

28.02 (4) SALE OF STATE FOREST LANDS. (a) Lands outside state forest boundaries may be sold pursuant to s. 24.085.

- (b) Lands within state forest boundaries may be sold pursuant to s. 24.085, after public hearing in the county courthouse of the county in which the lands to be sold are located, following at least 2 weekly notices in a newspaper having general circulation in the county, and in the official state paper, for the following purposes only:
  - 1. To a local unit of government when required for a public use.
- 2. To others for the purpose of making land adjustments due to occupancy resulting from errors of survey.
- To convey good quality, arable land.
  To settle land title disputes.
  To public utilities and co-operative associations when needed for power and telephone substations, transformers, booster stations and similar installations.
  - 6. When no longer needed for conservation purposes.

SECTION 2. 28.02 (7) of the statutes is repealed.
